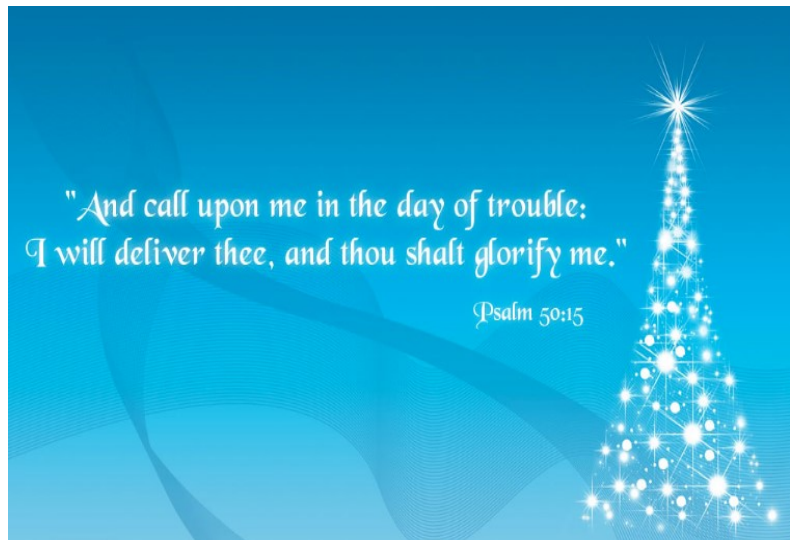

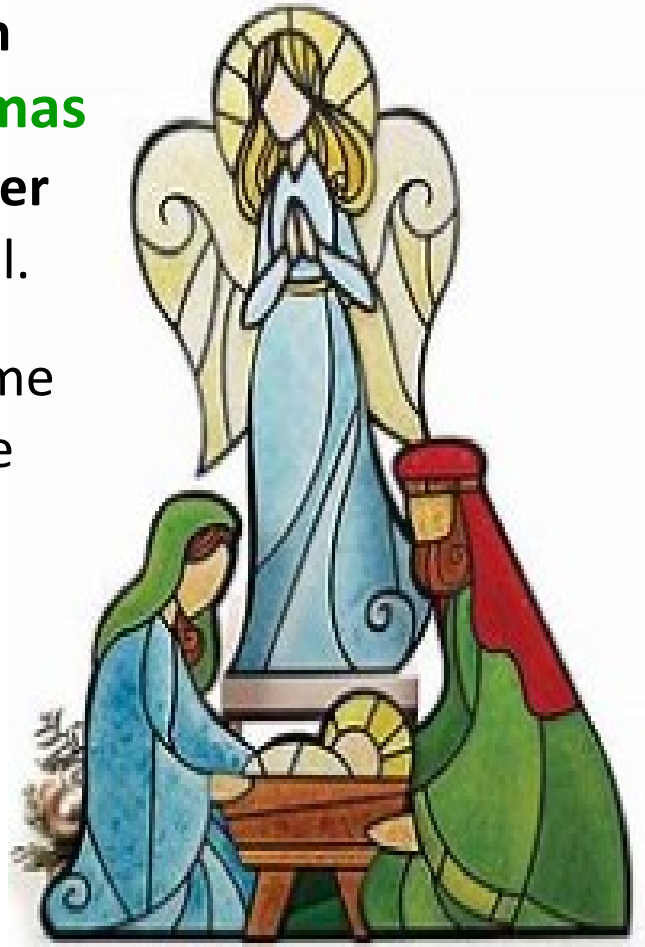


Our **Religious Education Program** is having its **6th Annual Christmas Pageant** on **Saturday, December 16th at 2:00 PM** in the Parish Hall.
