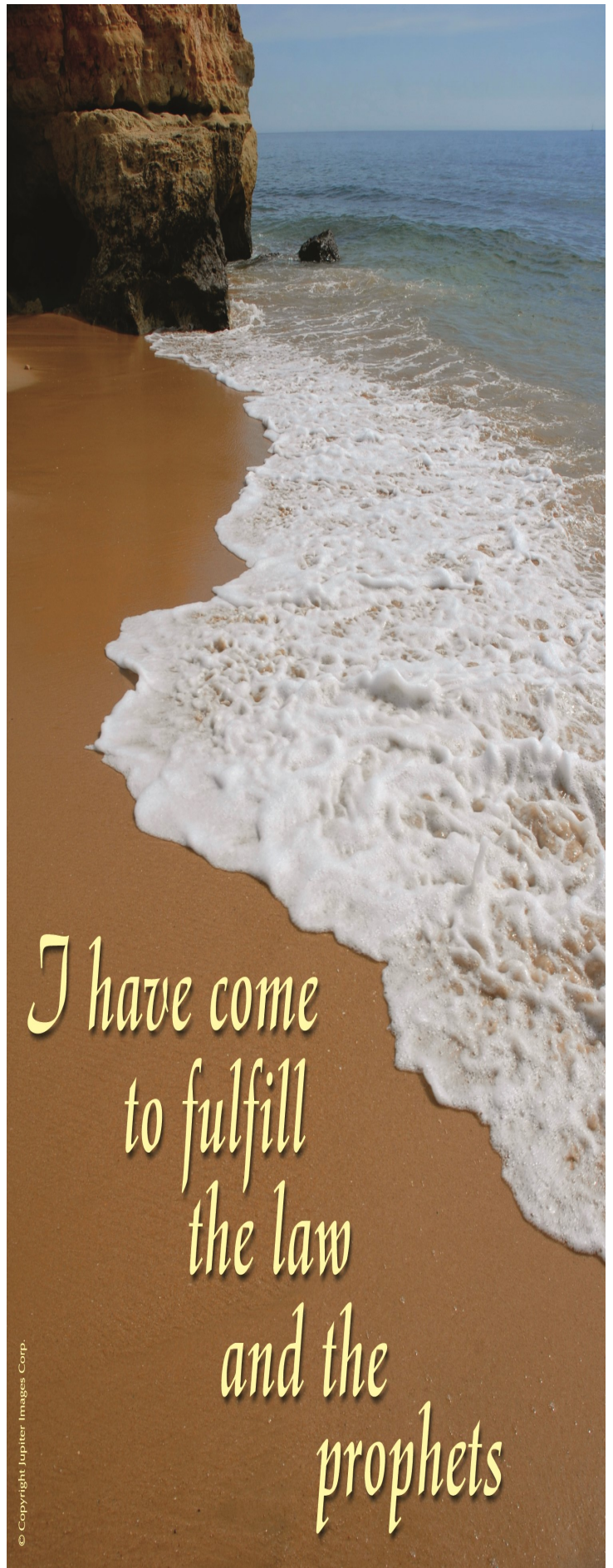
New Beginnings
