### PARKING UPDATE

Parishioners who drive to our church for the 11:00 am Sunday Mass know that it can be extremely difficult to find a parking spot close to the church. For some, this is an inconvenience but for those with mobility issues, it is much more. As a step to mitigate parking problems for those who **must** park near the church, the Convent parking lot will be reserved for those attending the 11:00 am Mass. Access to the Convent parking lot will be restricted until 10:30 am, at which time it will be opened for people who are attending the 11:00 am Mass and who have mobility issues. We will be using the honor system, so in the spirit of accommodating those who need to park close to the church, we ask that you not park in the lot if you are able to walk to church from a parking spot further away.

We hope that this arrangement is a demonstration of how our English and Korean speaking parishioners can and will continue to work together for everyone's benefit. We thank you for your anticipated cooperation in helping to make our church more accessible to everyone, especially people who might otherwise not be able to attend Mass.
