

#### **PARKING UPDATE**

Parishioners who drive to our church for the 11:00 am Sunday Mass know that it can be extremely difficult to find a parking spot close to the church. For some, this is an inconvenience but for those with mobility issues, it is much more. As a step to mitigate parking problems for those who **must** park near the church, the Convent parking lot will be reserved for those attending the 11:00 am Mass. Access to the Convent parking lot will be restricted until 10:30 am, at which time it will be opened for people who are attending the 11:00 am Mass and who have mobility issues.
